



General Tournament Outline

- 1. Each team is guaranteed a minimum of 3 games.**
- 2. Round robin play will occur between 11-3pm.**
 - a. In the 11am timeslot the top three divisional and the top two campus wide teams will advance to finals**
 - b. In the 1pm timeslot the top two campus wide teams and top divisional team will advance to finals**
- 3. Round robin ranking will be decided based on Win-Loss record. In the event of a tie, the higher ranking team will be decided based on the following:**
 - a. Head to Head record between the two tied teams**
 - b. Overall Point Differential**
 - c. Overall Points For**
 - d. Overall Least Points Against**
 - e. Coin Toss**
- 4. Playoff play will occur between 3pm-5pm.**
- 5. Playoffs will consist of semi-finals and finals.**
- 6. Playoffs will follow the same rules. In the event of a tie – each team will be given an offensive run until the tie is abolished.**

Gameplay Rules

Flag football rules apply except for the following major changes (please refer to the general rules for entire rules set):

- a. Each game will be 30 minutes running time, two fifteen minute halves, with stoppage time in the last minute.**
- b. Teams are able to call 1 time out that lasts 30 seconds.**
- c. A maximum of 5 players on the field at any time, minimum of 4 players to start.**

- d. Co-rec ratio must be maintained – minimum 2 players of each gender on the field at all times.**
- e. The Rusher – During scrimmage plays, the defense will have one player – the rusher – pursue the quarter back. The rusher must wait for a count of 5 Steamboats until they can cross the line of scrimmage to rush the QB.**
- f. Safety – if an offensive player steps out of bounds beyond the 45 yard line, it will be ruled a safety, however no points will be rewarded. The offensive team will lose possession and the defensive team will gain possession of the ball on the 40 yard line.**
- g. Interceptions– An interception by the defensive team will result in a turnover and the play will be called dead. The intercepting team will begin their offensive drive from the 50 yard line.**
