UBC Card Policy - In order for a player to participate in a game or event, a valid UBC Student card or UBC Staff/faculty card must be produced prior to each game. In the event that a player's name appears on the REC produced roster or participant list, a piece of government issued photo ID may be used in place of the Student or Staff card. As a result, only valid UBC student and staff cards will be accepted for participation in drop-in programs, roster additions prior to the roster declaration, and substitutions.

Team Name Policy - Please ensure that the selected name is in good taste and is not offensive to individuals or groups identified in the UBC Policy on Discrimination and Harassment (characteristics protected are age, race, colour, ancestry, place of origin, political belief, religion, marital status, family status, physical or mental disability, sex, sexual orientation and unrelated criminal convictions). UBC REC reserves the right to refuse inappropriate names.

Supplementary Discipline Policy - Individuals or teams that breach these guidelines while participating in any UBC REC activity, or are involved in an incident of misconduct in, at, or surrounding a UBC REC activity or facility that is beyond the reasonable and acceptable limits of that activity, will be subject to review and, if necessary, appropriate disciplinary action. In cases where the severity of the incident is extreme, UBC REC reserves the right to report any incident to the University Committee on Student Discipline for review and possible further sanctions following the disciplinary actions taken within the UBC REC program.
